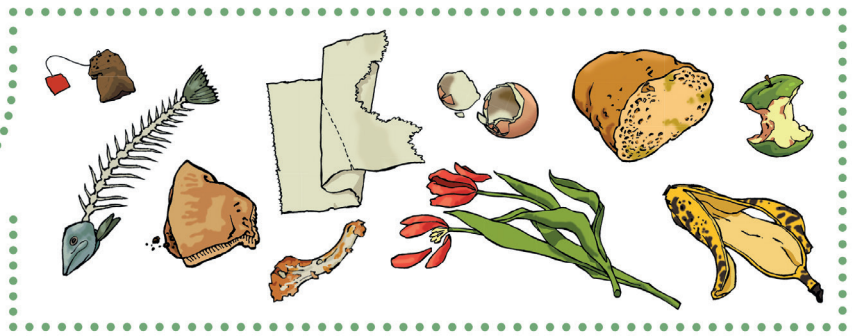


# HOW TO SORT HOUSEHOLD WASTE

## Place food waste in the brown bin

Food waste should be put in plastic bags, which will be sorted out at the anaerobic digestion plant. Only put food waste in the food waste bag: no lollipop sticks or plastic on bits of cucumber. For the production of biogas to function, there must only be food waste inside the bags in the brown bin. Be sure to double knot the bags.



## Place residual waste in the green bin

In the green bin, put what remains after sorting out glass, metal, plastic, and paper packaging, as well as newspapers and food waste. Be sure to double knot the plastic bags! Anything that cannot be placed in the bag should be dropped off at the recycling center (ÅVC).



## Packaging, glass, metal and paper + newspapers

Packaging and Newspaper Collection Service (Förpacknings- och Tidningsinsamlingen AB) is responsible for the collection of packaging and newspapers. Therefore, nothing else should be left at the recycling station. Do not put envelopes in the recycling station's newspaper collection bin. Instead, deposit them with residual waste in the green bin



## Hazardous waste

Households may leave hazardous waste free of charge at environmental stations, such as oils, solvents, paint, car batteries and more. Environmental stations can usually be found at the recycling center (ÅVC).



At ÅVC, you can also leave clothing, plastics, furniture, electronics, discarded appliances, excess or old building materials, and garden waste. You can also leave iron, asbestos, porcelain and impregnated wood.

## Medications

Remains of medicinal products and used syringes can be left at a pharmacy or equivalent.
